TES install Icom System into Brook House Immigration Removal Centre

Brook House IRC is a newly built facility that required a complete secure radio communications system to operate across the whole of the site.

After initial discussions and site surveys, TES Limited identified the customer's requirements and designed a multi-channel Icom RMS-NET radio system. This system offers controlled voice communications for the security and facility management. The solution also enables the use of text and status messaging to assist in the efficient use of the radio channels allocated to the centre. The RMS-NET provides a log of all calls made to and from control. This could be used to look into the radio system activity at any time.

In February 2009 TES Limited fully installed and commissioned the system ready for the opening of the new facility at the Gatwick.

In continuation of our service to G4S, TES Limited provide an ongoing comprehensive maintenance service supporting the infrastructure and all the mobile units onsite.
